Costumes:

- FDK through Fifth Grades: Students **should not** wear their costumes but should bring them to school in their backpacks. They will have their regularly scheduled lunch/recess periods and will have time after recess and lunch to change into their costumes. Staff will be available to assist and monitor students during this time.
- Please **do not** send the following items to school: masks, make-up, colored hairspray, fake blood, or any kind of weapon (even if it is plastic). Please save these things for Halloween night.

Parade:

- The parade will begin at 2:15.
- The children will exit Door #20 (in the back) and make 2 loops around the school. Visitors who would like to watch the parade may stand outside the building. However, please keep all sidewalks clear and stand away from the doors so the children are not overwhelmed. Also, please leave all pets at home on this day.

Parking:

Parking is limited, so it is best to arrive early. Please be aware that parking is prohibited on Fairfield Lane and is restricted to the north side (house side) of Preston Lane. Please honor the "No Parking" signs on Preston and Fairfield.

- Please **do not** park in the fire/bus lanes in front of the school or in the Parent Pick-Up lane at the back of the school.

No Treats:

No treats (including candy) can be brought to any of the parties. This is a district policy.

Only designated room parents who are working the parties can attend the parties and must check in at the Community Room on party day. You must have a valid I.D. in order to enter the building.

- Please enter in the **back** of the school through Doors #18 and #19 (the Community Room).
- Please make other arrangements for siblings on these days.
