Who do I call to report a child absence?

A parent or legal guardian must call 630-636-2601 by 10am. If a call is not received, the absence will be unexcused. The reporting of absences requires a phone call; notes are not accepted.

How do I find out the bus route for my child?

Health Information

Health Required Registration Forms:

Immunization Record

Immunizations are required prior to the start of the school year. Students who do not receive proper immunizations will be excluded from attending school after a specified date.

Dental Exam

Prescribed by Illinois Department of Public Health. This should be completed prior to August.

6th Grade Physical

The state of IL requires all incoming 6th graders to have a complete health physical. Failure to provide a school physical will result in school exclusion after a specified date.
